RESPONSIBLE TO: Camp Chrysalis Program Director

ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Be at least 18 years of age
- 2. Visual and auditory ability to monitor, identify, and respond to hazards and emergency situations.
- 3. Good health and vitality, including the ability to work outdoors in summer temperatures and the ability to traverse uneven surfaces for approximately 5 miles daily.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Attend required training, either virtually before arriving or upon arrival at camp.
- 2. Volunteer at least 6 hours per day when living on site, or 8 hours per week if not living on site.
- 3. When working in the kitchen
 - a. Perform all the duties pertaining to the kitchen in consultation with the Food Service Director/Cook.
 - b. Help prepare and serve high quality nutritious meals and snacks in a spirit of high hospitality.
 - c. Keep kitchen, food storage area, refrigerators and freezers neat, clean, sanitized and organized.
 - d. Keep dining hall and adjacent area clean and neat. Help with daily dish washing at each meal.
 - e. Maintain kitchen equipment in good condition. Report all needed repairs to the Director.
- 4. When working in program areas
 - a. Work with campers and staff at the high ropes course, waterfront, hiking, archery course, and/or other areas as assigned by the program director.
 - b. Attend community/volunteer meetings as assigned and share information with other staff partners.
- 5. Exercise safety precautions and teach campers to care for equipment and the property of others.
- 6. Actively assist and support the rest of the staff community in the camp ministry program by participating in, planning, preparing or leading camp activities including all-camp activities, archery, arts and crafts, campfires, camp store, fishing, nature programming, recreation programming, ropes course activities, theme meals, water activities, worships, assisting in KP, assisting in camper activities, supervision of campers or any other activity assigned by directors.
